

Leading the industry in recycled glass content


Visy's industry-leading average of 64% recycled glass in its packaging* represents a 6% increase compared to the 2023 financial year.

The figure is higher for recycled coloured glass (amber and green) at 75%*, with up to 90% recycled glass already in some of our green and amber bottles.

A Visy glass container with 70% recycled content uses up to 30% less energy to make than a container with no recycled content. This lower emissions product, keeps glass out of landfill, reduces our reliance on virgin material and helps your brand achieve your sustainability targets.

We are investing over half a billion dollars in glass recycling and remanufacturing to reach our 70% target.
